

### 5. QUICK USER GUIDE

This washing machine automatically adjusts the level of the water to the type and quantity of washing. This system gives a reduction in energy consumption and a saving in washing times.

## **Program selection**

- Turn on the washing machine and select the required program.
- Adjust the washing temperature if necessary and press the required "option" buttons.
- Press the START/PAUSE button to start washing.

Should power go out when the washing machine is running, a special memory saves the settings and, when power returns, the machine resumes the cycle from where it left off.

 At the end of the programme, the message "End" will appear on the display or, on some models, all wash stage indicator lights will turn on.

Wait until the DOOR LOCKED light has gone out before opening the door.

Turn off the washing machine.

For any type of wash, see the program table and follow the operating sequence as indicated.



# WARNING:

Don't touch the display while inserting the plug because the machines calibrates the systems during the first seconds: touching the display, the machine couldn't work property. In this case, remove the plug and repeat the operation.

# PROGRAMME selector with OFF position

When the programme selector is turned the display lights up to show the settings for the programme selected.

For energy saving, at the end of the cycle or with an inactivity period, the display level contrast will decrease.

N.B.: To switch the machine off, turn the programme selector to the OFF position.

- Press the START/PAUSE button to start the selected cycle.
- Once a programme is selected the programme selector remains stationary on the selected programme till cycle ends.
- "End" will appear in the display at the end of the program and the DOOR LOCKED light will go off, it is now possible to open the door.
- Switch off the washing machine by turning the selector to OFF.

The programme selector must be returned to the OFF position at the end of each cycle or when starting a subsequent wash cycle prior to the next programme being selected and started.

### START/PAUSE button

Close the door BEFORE selecting the button START/PAUSE.

Press to start the selected cycle.

When the START/PAUSE button has been pressed, the appliance can take few seconds before it starts working.

# ADD OR REMOVE ITEMS AFTER THE PROGRAMMES HAS STARTED (PAUSE)

- Press and hold the START/PAUSE button for about 2 seconds (some indicator light and the time remaining indicator will flash, showing that the machine has been paused).
- Wait until the DOOR LOCKED light has gone out before opening the door.

Before you open the door, please check water level is below the door opening to avoid flooding.

 After you have added or removed items, close the door and press the START/PAUSE button (the programme will start from where it left off).

#### CANCELLING THE PROGRAMME

- To cancel the programme, set the selector to the OFF position.
- Wait 2 minutes until the safety device unlocks the door.

### **DELAY START button**

 This button allows you to pre-programme the wash cycle to delay the start of the cycle for up to 24 hours.

- To delay the start use the following procedure:
  - Select the required programme.
  - Press the delay start button once to activate it (h00 appears on the display) and then press it again to set a 1 hour delay (h01 appears on the display). The pre-set delay increases by 1 hour each time the button is pressed, until h24 appears on the display, at which point pressing the button again will reset the delay start to zero.
  - Confirm by pressing the START/PAUSE button. The delay countdown will begin and when it has finished the programme will start automatically.
- It is possible to cancel the delay start by turning the programme selector to **OFF**.

If there is any break in the power supply while the machine is operating, a special memory stores the selected programme and, when the power is restored, it continues where it left OFF.

The following options must be selected before pressing the START/PAUSE button.

## **OPTIONS** button

This button allows you to choose between three different options:

#### - PREWASHING

- This option allows you to make a prewash and it is particularly useful for heavily soiled loads (can be used only on some programmes as shown in the table of programmes).
- We recommend you use only 20% of the recommended quantities shown on the detergent pack.

### - AQUAPLUS

- This option (available only in some programmes) allows you to wash the load in a much larger quantity of water and this, together with the new combined action of the drum rotation cycles, where water is filled and emptied, will give you garments which have been cleaned and rinsed to perfection so that the detergent dissolves completely, ensuring an efficient cleaning action.
- This function is for the people with delicate and sensitive skin.
- This function can be used for children's items and for washing of very dirty items, for which you are required to use a lot of detergent, or for washing of Towels whose fibres have the tendency to hold the detergent.

#### - HYGIENE +

Activated when you set 60°C of temperature. This option allows deep cleaning of your clothes by maintaining the same temperature for the whole wash.

If an option is selected that is not compatible with the selected programme then the option indicator light first flashes and then goes off.

### **RAPID / STAIN LEVEL button**

This button allows you to choose between two different options, depending on the selected programme.

#### - RAPID

The button becomes active when you select the RAPID (14/30/44 Min.) programme on the knob and allows you to select one of three durations indicated.

#### - STAIN LEVEL button

 Once the programme has been selected the wash time set for that programme will be automatically shown. • This option allows you to choose between 3 levels of wash intensity modifying the length of the programme, depending on how much the fabrics are soiled (can only be used on some programmes as shown in the table of programmes).

TEMPERATURE SELECTION button

- This button allows you to change the temperature of the wash cycles.
- It is not possible to raise the temperature over the maximum allowed for the programme, in order to protect the fabrics.
- If you want carry out a cold wash all the indicators must be off.

### **SPIN SPEED button**

- By pressing this button, it is possible to reduce the maximum speed, and if you wish, the spin cycle can be cancelled.
- If the label does not indicate specific information, it is possible to use the maximum spin expected in the program.

To prevent damage to the fabrics, it is not possible to increase the speed over the maximum allowed for the programme.

- To reactivate the spin cycle press the button until you reach the spin speed you would like to set.
- It is possible to modify the spin speed without pausing the machine.

An over dosing of detergent can cause excessive foaming. If the appliance detects the presence of excessive foam, it may exclude the spinning phase or extend the duration of the program and increase water consumption.

The machine is fitted with a special electronic device, which prevents the spin cycle should the load be unbalanced. This reduces the noise and vibration in the machine and so prolongs the life of your machine.

### **NIGHT & DAY button**


- This option reduces the intermediate spin speed to 400 rpm, where applicable, increase the water level during rinsing and keep the laundry immersed in water after the final rinse, in order to spread the fiber perfectly.
- During the phase in which the water is held in the tub, the relevant indicator light blink to show that the machine is at a standstill.
- Deselect the option to end the cycle with a spin dry (which may be reduced or cancelled using the appropriate button) and emptying phase.
- Thanks to electronic control, the water in the intermediate phases is emptied silently, making this option very useful for washing at night.

### **KEY LOCK**

- Pressing simultaneously the buttons TEMPERATURE SELECTION and SPIN SPEED for about 3 seconds, the machine allows you to lock the keys. In this way, you can avoid making accidental or unwanted changes if a button on the display is pressed accidently during a cycle.
- The key lock can be simply cancelled by pressing the two buttons simultaneously again or turning off the appliance.

## **Digital Display**

The display's indicator system allows you to be constantly informed about the status of the machine.



### 1) DOOR LOCKED INDICATOR LIGHT

 The indicator light is illuminated when the door is fully closed.

Close the door BEFORE selecting the START/PAUSE button.

 When START/PAUSE is pressed on the machine with the door closed, the indicator will flash momentarily and then illuminate.

If the door is not properly closed, the light will continue to flash for about 7 seconds, after which the start command will be automatically delete. In this case, close the door in the proper way and press the START/PAUSE button.

 Wait until the DOOR LOCKED light has gone out before opening the door.

### 2) SPIN SPEED

This show the spin speed of the selected programme that can be changed or omitted by the relevant button.

# 3) WASH TEMPERATURE INDICATOR LIGHTS

This shows the washing temperature of the selected programme that can be changed (where allowed) by the relevant button.

If you want carry out a cold wash all the

If you want carry out a cold wash all the indicators must be off.

### 4) CYCLE DURATION

- When a programme is selected the display automatically shows the cycle duration, which can vary, depending on the options selected.
- Once the programme has started you will be kept informed constantly of the time remaining to the end of the wash.
- The appliance calculates the time to the end of the selected programme based upon a standard loading, during the cycle, the appliance corrects the time to that applicable to the size and composition of the load.

### 5) STAIN LEVEL INDICATORS LIGHTS

- Once the programme has been selected, the indicator light will automatically show the stain level set for that programme.
- Selecting a different stain level the relevant indicator will light up.

### 6) OPTIONS INDICATOR LIGHTS

The indicator lights show the option that can be selected by the relevant button.

### 7) KEY LOCK INDICATOR LIGHT

The indicator light show that the keys are locked.

### 8) WI-FI (some models only)

 In the models with the Wi-Fi option, the icon indicates that the Wi-Fi system is working.


# 9) Kg MODE (function active only on certain programmes)

 During the first minutes of the cycle, the "Kg MODE" indicator remain on while the intelligent sensor will weigh the laundry and adjust the cycle time, water and electricity consumption accordingly.

- Through every wash phase "Kg MODE" allows to monitor information on the wash load in the drum and in the first minutes of the wash it:
- adjusts the amount of water required;
- determines the length of the wash cycle;
- controls rinsing according to the type of fabric selected to be washed it;
- adjusts the rhythm of drum rotation for the type of fabric being washed;
- recognizes the presence of lather, increasing, if necessary, the amount of water during rinsing;
- adjusts the spin speed according to the load, thus avoiding any imbalance.

COTTON PROGRAMME WITH A TEMPERATURE OF 60°C.

COTTON PROGRAMME WITH A TEMPERATURE OF 40°C.

These programmes are suitable to clean normally soiled cotton laundry and they are the most efficient programmes in terms of combined energy and water consumptions for washing cotton laundry.

These programmes have been developed to be compliant with the temperature on the wash label on the garments and the actual water temperature may slightly differ from the declared temperature of the cycle.

(•) Only with PREWASH option selected (programmes with PREWASH option available).

# (Only for models with liquid detergent compartment)

When only a limited number of articles have stains which require treatment with liquid bleaching agents, preliminary removal of stain can be carried out in the washing machine.

Pour the bleach into the liquid bleach container, inserted into the compartment marked "2" in the detergent drawer, and set the special programme RINSE.

When this phase has terminated, turn the programme selector to the OFF position, add the rest of the fabrics and proceed with a normal wash on the most suitable programme.

- When a programme is selected, on the display is shown the display shows the recommended wash temperature that can be reduced (where allowed) by the relevant button.
- For the programmes shown you can adjust the duration and intensity of the wash using the STAIN LEVEL button.
- 3) Selecting the RAPID program on the knob, it will be possible to select with the RAPID button, one of the three rapid programs available among 14', 30' and 44'.

### **Programmes selection**

To clean different types of fabrics and various levels of dirt, the washing machine has specific programs to meet every need of washing (see table of programmes).

### ALL IN ONE technology

This washing machine is equipped with an innovative system with an high pressure jet that sprays a mixture of water and detergent directly into the load. The special motor movement used in this machine manages the drum movement during the start up of each programme, in conjunction with the high pressure jet spraying the detergent mixture into the load, the cycle includes a set of spin actions that helps the detergent solution to penetrate into the fibers, helping dirt removal and ensuring the best available wash performance. The ALL IN ONE system is also used during the water load phases where the high pressure iet aids the complete removal of detergent residues trapped in the clothes

### All In One 20°C

Thanks to **ALL IN ONE** technology, this innovative programme, allows you to wash fabrics such as cottons, synthetics and mixed fabrics at 20°C with a performance which is comparable to a 40°C wash. The consumption of this program is about 50% of a conventional 40°C. Cottons wash.

# IMPORTANT WASH PERFORMANCE ADVICE:

- New, coloured garments should be washed separately for at least 5 or 6 washes.
- Certain large dark items such as jeans and towels should always be washed separately.
- Never mix NON COLOURFAST fabrics.

### All Hygiene

Thanks to the **ALL IN ONE** technology, this program ensures deep cleaning by optimizing the cycle in terms of temperature and rinses, eliminating allergens and detergent residues. Ideal for sensitive skin. Designed for cotton garments, it provides a 60°C temperature and is recommended for a reduced load

### All In One 59 Min.

This programme allows you to wash mixed fabrics such as cottons, synthetics and mixed fabrics in only 59 minutes, using the full load of the washing machine, at 40°C (or less) temperature. This programme is particularly suited to slightly dirty fabrics.

### Rapid (14-30-44 Min.)

Washing cycle suggested for low loads and slightly dirty. With this program it is recommended to reduce the quantity of detergent normally used, in order to avoid unnecessary waste. Selecting the RAPID program and acting on the button you can choose one of three programs available.

### **Dark Colours**

Program designed to mix all dark garments and to avoid the loss of colour and the formation of creases. We recommend the use of liquid detergent.

### Wool

This program performs a wash cycle dedicated to the wool fabrics that can be washed in a washing machine, or the articles to be washed by hand.

### Handwash & Silk

This programme allows a delicate washing cycle for garments specified as "Hand Wash only" and laundry items made from Silk or specified as "Wash as Silk" on the fabric label.

### Rinse

This program performs 3 rinses with an intermediate spin (which can be reduced or excluded by using the appropriate button). It is used for rinsing any type of fabric, for example after a wash carried out by hand.

### Drain & Spin

The program completes the drain and a maximum spin. It is possible to delete or reduce the spin with the SPIN SPEED button.

#### **Shirts**

The washing cycle is optimized to reduce the creation of creases, keeping an excellent washing performance. It is also possible to further reduce the spin speed, to ensure an easier ironing.

### Delicates

This program has reduced periods of drum rotation during the cycle and is particularly suitable or washing delicate fabrics. The wash cycle and rinses are carried out with a high level of water to ensure the best performance.

#### Mixed

The washing and rinsing optimise the speed and rhythm of the drum action and water levels. The gentle spin, ensures a reduced formation of creases in the fabric.

### Cottons <

This program is suitable to clean normally soiled cotton laundry and it is the most efficient program in terms of combined energy and water consumptions for washing cotton laundry.

### Whites

Made to have a perfect washing. The final spin at maximum speed gives more efficient removal.


### **Sports**

This programme is specially designed to wash mixed sportswear fabrics that cannot be washed on hotter programmes and is designed to remove the dirt and staining created by participation in sports activities.

# 4.1 Control panel



## 4.2 Operating instructions

## 4.2.1 Setting the time

When the microwave oven is energized, "0:00" will be displayed in LED screen and buzzer will ring once.

- 1. Press (Kitchen Timer/Clock) twice and the figures for hours will start flashing.
- 2. Turn to adjust the hour; the input value should be between 0 and 23.
- 3. Press (Kitchen Timer/Clock) and the figures for minutes will start flashing.
- 4. Turn to adjust the minutes; the input value should be between 0 and 59.
- 5. Press (Kitchen Timer/Clock) to finish time setting. ":" symbol will flash, and the time will light.



If you press 

(Stop/Cancel) during time setting, oven will automatically return back to previous mode.

# 4.2.2 Cooking with microwave oven

- 2. Press (Microwave) again or turn to select the desired power. Each time you press the key, "P100", "P80", "P50", "P30" or "P10" will be displayed respectively.

- 3. Press ▷ (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to confirm and turn ③ to set the cooking time to a value between 0:05 and 95:00.
- 4. Press ▷ (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) again to start cooking.
- Press <sup>MW</sup> (Microwave) once and "P100" will be displayed in the screen.
- 6. Press <sup>MW</sup> (Microwave) once again or turn <sup>№</sup> to set 80% microwave power.



**Example:** If you want to use 80% microwave power to cook for 20 minutes, you can operate the oven with the following steps.

- 7. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm and "P 80" will be displayed in the screen.
- 8. Turn voto adjust the cooking time until the oven displays "20:00".
- 9. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start cooking.

The steps for adjusting the time in coding button are as below:

# 4. 3 Cooking with grill or combination mode

- 1. Press (Grill/Combination) and "G" will be displayed in LED screen. Press (Grill/Combination) repeatedly or turn to select the desired power. Each time you press the key, "G", "C-1" or "C-2" will be displayed respectively.
- 2. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to confirm and turn to set the cooking time to a value between 0:05 and 95:00.
- 3. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) again to start cooking.



**Example:** If you want to use 55% microwave power and 45% grill power (C-1) to cook for 10 minutes, you can operate the oven with the following steps.

- 1. Press <sup>♥♥</sup> (Grill/Combination) once and "G" will be displayed in the screen.
- 2. Press ⇔ (Grill/Combination) once again or turn ♥ to select the Combination 1 mode.
- 3. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm and "C-1" will be displayed in the screen.

- 4. Turn 👽 to adjust the cooking time until the oven displays "10:00".
- 5. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start cooking.

# 4.3.1 (Grill/Combination) Keypad instructions

When half the grill time passes, the oven sounds twice, and this is normal. In order to have a better grilling effect, you should turn the food over, close the door, and then press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to continue cooking. If no operation is performed, the oven will continue cooking.

# 4.4 Quick start

- 2. In microwave oven cooking, grill and combination cooking or defrost by time modes, the cooking time will increase by 30 seconds each time you press (Start/+30 Sec/Confirm).

3. In standby mode, turn  $\Im$  counterclockwise to set the cooking time in order to start cooking with 100% microwave power and press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to start cooking.



In auto menu and defrost by weight modes, pressing  $\triangleright$  (Start/+30Sec/Confirm) will not increase the cooking time.

# 4.5 Defrost by weight

- 1. Press (Defrost by weight) for once.
- 2. Turn  $\Im$  to select the weight of food from 100 to 2000 a.
- 3. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start

# 4.6 Defrost by time

- 1. Press (Defrost by time) for once.
- 2. Turn to select the defrost time. The maximum time is 95 minutes.
- 3. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start defrost. Defrost power is P30 and cannot be changed.

# 4.7 Kitchen timer (counter)

Your oven is equipped with an automatic counter which is not linked with the oven functions and can be used separately at the kitchen (it can be set to max. 95 minutes.)

- 1. Press (Kitchen Timer/Clock) for once and 00:00 will be displayed in LED screen.
- 2. Turn v to enter the correct time.
- 3. Press ▷ (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm the setting.
- 4. When the countdown from the entered time reaches to 00:00, the buzzer will ring for 5 times. If the time is set (24-hour system), current time will be displayed in LED screen.

Press (Stop/Cancel) to abort the timer at anytime.



Kitchen timer functions different than 24-hours system. Kitchen timer is just a timer.

## 4.8 Auto menu

- 1. Turn clockwise to select the desired menu. Menus between "A-1" and "A-8", namely pizza, meat, vegetable, pasta, potato, fish, beverage and popcorn, will be displayed.
- 2. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm.
- 3. Turn to choose the default weight in accordance with the menu chart.
- 4. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start cooking.



**Example:** If you want to use "Auto Menu" to cook 350 g fish:

- 1. Turn sclockwise until "A-6" is displayed in the screen.
- 2. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm.
- 3. Turn 🔮 to select the weight of fish until "350" is displayed in the screen.
- 4. Press (Start/+30 Sec./Confirm) to start cooking.

# 4.9 Multi-step cooking

At most 2 steps can be set for cooking. In multistep cooking, if one step is defrosting, then defrosting must be placed in the first step.



If you want to thaw food for 5 minutes and then cook with 80% microwave power for 7 minutes, perform the following steps:

- 1. Press (Defrost by time) for once.
- 2. Turn 🔮 to select the defrost time until "5:00" is displayed in the screen.
- 3. Press (Microwave) once and "P100" will be displayed in the screen.
- 4. Press <sup>MW</sup> (Microwave) once again or turn <sup>™</sup> to set 80% microwave power.
- 5. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to confirm and "P 80" will be displayed in the screen.
- 6. Turn 👽 to adjust the cooking time until the oven displays "7:00".
- 7. Press (Start/+30Sec./Confirm) to start cooking. Buzzer will sound once for the first step and defrost time countdown will start. Buzzer will sound once again when entering the second cooking step. Buzzer will sound for 5 times at the end of cooking.

# 4.10 Query function

- 1. In microwave, grill and combination modes, press ∰ (Microwave) or ∰ (Grill/Combination) and the current power level will be displayed for 3 seconds. After 3 seconds, the oven will return to the previous mode.
- 2. While cooking, press (Kitchen Timer/Clock) and the current time will be displayed for 3 seconds.

### 4.11 Child lock

- 1. **Locking:** In standby mode, press (Stop/Cancel) for 3 seconds and a buzzer will sound indicating that the child lock is activated. If the time is already set, current time will also be displayed; otherwise will be displayed in the LED screen.
- 2. **Unlocking:** To disable the child lock, press (Stop/Cancel) for 3 seconds and a long "beep" will sound indicating that the child lock is disabled.

# 4.12 Opening the oven door

Press (Open door) and the oven door will be opened.



If the door cannot be opened with "open door" key in model MGB 25333 BG (e.g., due to power failure), you can open the door with vacuum lifter for opening the door manually.



# PROGRAMME SELECTION AND SPECIAL FUNCTIONS

(Use in conjunction with programme guide)

## **Programme settings**

- Open the door and place the dirty dishes inside the appliance.
- Press the "ON/OFF" button for about 2 seconds.

All the programme indicator lights will flash.

- Choose a programme by pressing the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button. The selected program indicator light will flash.
- If you wish to select an option, press the option button (the corresponding indicator light will light up).

The option button can be selected or deselected WITHIN one minute of the programme commencing.

- Press the "START" button (the selected programme indicator light will stop flashing and remain on.
- Close the door (after an audible signal has sounded, the programme will start automatically).

WITHIN one minute of the programme commencing, another programme can be selected, simply by pressing the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button.

## **Programme interruption**

Opening the door when a programme is running is not recommended especially during the main wash and final hot rinse phases. However, if the door is opened while a programme is running (for example, to add dishes) the machine stops automatically.

Close the door, without pressing any buttons. The cycle will start from where it left off.



### WARNING!

If you open the door during the drying cycle, an audible audio signal advises you that the drying cycle has not yet finished.

### Changing a running programme

Proceed as follows to change or cancel a running program:

- Open the door.
- Hold the "RESET" button down for at least 3 seconds.

  Some audible signals will sound and the programme indicator lights will turn on and off individually and sequentially.
- The running programme will be cancelled and all the programme indicator lights will flash.
- At this point a new programme can be set.



### $^{\perp}$ WARNING!

Before starting a new programme, you should check that there is still detergent in the dispenser. If necessary, top up the dispenser.

## **Programme operations**

When a programme is running the relevant indicator light will remain on and the 3 **"PROGRAMME STATUS"** indicator lights ("WASH" Q, "RINSE" (), and "DRY" () will light singularly and in sequence to indicate the current phase.

If there is any break in the power supply while the dishwasher is operating, a special memory stores the selected programme and, when the power is restored, it continues where it left off.

## Programme end

A 5 second alarm will sound (if not muted) 3 times at 30 second intervals and the programme indicator light will flash to indicate that the washing programme has finished. The dishwasher will automatically switch off.

### **Option buttons**

### "SUPER ECO" button

This button provides an energy and time saving of 25% on average (according to the select cycle) reducing the wash water temperature and the drying time during the final rinse.

This programme is recommended for light soil washes, and for slightly wet dishes that are not fully dry, & improved drying results. We advise you to leave the door of the Dishwasher half-open at the end of the cycle, to allow for a natural circulation of air inside the dishwasher.

## Salt empty indicator

This model is provided with an indicator light on the control panel which will light up when it is necessary to reload the salt container.

The appearance of white stains on dishes is generally a warning sign that the salt container needs filling.

## "RESET" button for "SALT EMPTY" light

After filling the salt container, you should press this button for a few seconds, until the corresponding indicator light switches off.

WARNING!

If you press the reset button without filling the salt container, this will interfere with the correct functioning of the salt indicator light.

IMPORTANT
In order to guarantee the correct
functioning of the salt indicator
light, YOU MUST ALWAYS FULLY
REPLENISH THE SALT CONTAINER.

### "DELAY START" button

The dishwasher start time can be set with this button, delaying the start by 3, 6 or 9 hours.

Proceed as follows to set a delayed start:

- Choose a programme by pressing the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button.
- Press the "DELAY START" button (each time the button is pressed the start will be delayed by 3, 6 or 9 hours respectively and the corresponding time indicator light will illuminate).
- To start the countdown, press the "START" button (the set time indicator light will start to flash).

If a 9 hour delay is set, countdown will be displayed by the **6h** indicator light after 3 hours and the **3h** indicator light after 6 hours.

At the end of the last 3 hours (at the end of countdown) the **3h** indicator light will stop flashing and remain on to indicate the washing phase and the programme will start automatically.

If countdown has not ended, whereby the programme has not yet started, it is possible to change or cancel the delayed start and select another programme or to select/deselect the option button, proceeding as follows:

■ Hold the "RESET" button down for at least 3 seconds. Some audible signals will sound and the programme indicator lights will turn on

and off individually and sequentially.

- The delayed start and the selected programme will be cancelled.

  The programme indicator lights will flash.
- Press the "DELAY START" button to set another delayed start time (the corresponding indicator light will turn on).
- A new programme can be set after a delayed time has been changed or cancelled or an option button can be selected or deselected.

# Alarm mute for the PROGRAMME END

The alarm **for the programme** end may be muted as follows:

### **IMPORTANT**

The dishwasher must ALWAYS be off before start of this procedure.

- Hold down the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button and at the same time switch on the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button (a brief audible signal will sound).
- Keep the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button pressed for at least 15 seconds (during this time, 2 audible signals will sound).
- Release the button when the second audible signal sounds (3 "PROGRAMME SELECTION" indicator lights will come on).
- 4. Press the same button again: the 3 indicator lights (which indicate that the alarm is activated) will start flashing (to indicate that the alarm is off).
- Turn off the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button to confirm the new setting.

To turn the alarm on again, follow the same procedure.

# Memorization of the last programme used

The last programme used can be memorized by following the below:

#### **IMPORTANT**

The dishwasher must ALWAYS be off before start of this procedure.

 Hold down the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button and at the same time switch on the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button (a brief audible signal will sound).

- Keep the "PROGRAMME SELECTION" button pressed for at least 30 seconds (during this time, 3 audible signals will sound).
- **3.** Release the button when the **THIRD** audible signal sounds (all the indicator lights will flash).
- Press the same button again: the flashing indicator light (memorization off) will stop flashing and remain on (memorization on).
- Turn off the dishwasher by pressing the "ON/OFF" button to confirm the new setting.

To disable the memorization, follow the same procedure.

## Fault signals

If malfunctions or faults occur when a programme is running the indicator light that corresponds to the selected cycle will flash rapidly and the alarm sounds. In this event, turn the dishwasher off by pressing the "ON/OFF" button.

After checking to make sure the water inlet hose tap is open, that the drain hose is not bent and that the siphon or filters are not clogged, set the selected programme again.

If the anomaly persists, contact Customer Service Department.

### **IMPORTANT**

This dishwasher is equipped with an anti-overflow safety device which will automatically discharge any excess water should a problem occur.



### ★ WARNING!

To ensure the correct operation of the anti-overflow safety device, we recommend that the dishwasher is not moved or tilted during operation. If however it is necessary to tilt or move the dishwasher, please ensure that the washing cycle is complete and that there is no remaining water inside the dishwasher.

### ONE TOUCH

This appliance is equipped with **One Touch** technology that allows you to interact, via the App, with smartphones based on Android operating system and equipped with NFC (Near Field Communication) function.

■ Download on your smartphone the **Hoover Wizard** App.

The Hoover Wizard App is available for devices running both Android and iOS, both for tablets and for smartphones. However, you can interact with the machine and take advantage of the potential offered by One Touch only with Android smartphones equipped with NFC technology, according to following functional scheme:

- Programmes To select and launch new additional washing programmes.
- Clever Care Advanced settings, Water Hardness, "Clever Check-up", Filter-Clean and a troubleshooting guide.

■ Reports – Washing statistics and tips for a more efficient use of your machine.

### **HOW TO USE ONE TOUCH**

FIRST TIME - Machine registration

■ Enter the "Settings" menu of your Android smartphone and activate the NFC function inside the "Wireless & Networks" menu.


Depending on the smartphone model and its Android OS version, the process of the NFC activation may be different. Refer to the smartphone manual for more details.

- Switch the appliance on, then enable the One Touch mode by selecting the programme "P3", then pressing the "SUPER ECO" button.
- Open the App, create the user profile and register the appliance following the instructions on the phone display or the "Quick Guide" attached on the machine.


### **NEXT TIME - Regular usage**

- Every time you want to manage the machine through the App, first you have to enable the **One Touch** mode by switching the appliance on, then selecting the programme "P3", then pressing the "SUPER ECO" button.
- Make sure you have unlocked your phone (from stand-by mode) and you have activated the NFC function; then, follow the steps mentioned earlier.
- If you want to start a washing cycle, load the dishes and the detergent.
- Select the desired function in the App (e.g.: starting a programme, the "Clever Check-up" cycle, update statistics, etc...).
- Follow the instructions on the phone display, **KEEPING IT ON** the **OneTouch** logo on the machine dashboard, when requested to do so by the App.
- Close the door of the appliance.



### NOTES:

Place your smartphone so that the NFC antenna on its back matches the position of the One Touch logo on the appliance (as illustred below).



If you do not know the position of vour NFC antenna, slightly move the smartphone in a circular motion over the One Touch logo until the App confirms the connection. In order for the data transfer to be successful, it is essential TO KEEP SMARTPHONE ON DASHBOARD DURING THESE THE FEW SECONDS OF THE PROCEDURE: a message on the device will inform about the correct outcome of the operation and advise you when it is possible to move the smartphone awav.

Thick cases or metallic stickers on your smartphone could affect or prevent the transmission of data between machine and telephone. If necessary, remove them.

The replacement of some components of the smartphone (e.g. back cover, battery, etc...) with non-original ones, could result in the NFC antenna removal, preventing the full use of the App.

The management and the control of the machine via App is only possible "by proximity": it is therefore not possible to perform remote operations (e.g.: from another room; outside of the house).

## Wash with prewash

For wash programmes with prewash, it is advisable to add a second dose of detergent (max. 10 g) directly in the machine.
